The **European Citizen Science Association ECSA** (Verein der europäischen Bürgerwissenschaften e.V.) is a non-profit organisation under German law. ECSA supports the citizen science movement in Europe by various capacity building activities and initiates and performs research on citizen science. The project **Doing It Together science (DITOs)**, running under ECSA within the H2020 framework and led by UCL London, is meant to elevate public engagement with science across Europe from passive engagement with the process of developing science to an active one. Key approaches are citizen science and Do It Yourself (DIY) scientific efforts.
